A regular meeting of the Faculty Senate convened at 3:05 pm on September 16, 2025, at the Dalton Woods Auditorium at the LSU campus, the President being the Chair and Secretary being present. President Tirone announced alternates and guests. There was one public comment by Zane Sutor-Benfield. The minutes of the last meeting were adopted as amended.

In his report, President Tirone discussed the current climate regarding free speech, politics, general civility, and respect. He noted LSU's strong policies for academic freedom. He then discussed the President's Search. His criteria for the President, who will be in charge of core academic missions, is to have experience in academia as a faculty member. There were no questions from the floor.

The first item of special orders was "Faculty Senate Executive Committee Member-at-Large Election. Lathan made a motion to open the floor for nominations and hold the election for the Faculty Senate Executive Committee Member-at-Large. There were no nominations from the floor. Kristen Healy (Ag) and Seungwon Yang (HSE) each had three minutes to introduce themselves and discuss their interest in serving as member at large. Healy was elected with a majority of 26 votes.

The first item of new business was "Budget and Planning Advisory Committee Election". Cook made a motion to open the floor for nominations and hold the election for the Budget and Planning Advisory Committee. There were no nominations from the floor. The following faculty were elected by acclamation: James Canfield (HSE), Kenneth Lopata (Science), and Wei-Ling Song (Business).

The second item of new business was "Faculty Appeals Board Election". Cook made a motion to open the floor for nominations and hold the election for the Budget and Planning Advisory Committee. There were no nominations from the floor. The following faculty were elected by acclamation: Daniel Kuroda (Science) and Aaron Sheehan-Dean (HSS).

Jane Cassidy, Senior Vice Provost, then provided an update on the International Travel Registry. After a spirited discussion at the last meeting of the Facutly Senate, Vice Provost Cassidy heard the concerns of faculty and acted on them by streamlining the registry process within that of the current spend authorization. These changes will be rolled out in January 2026, which gives time to embed high risk travel information also into the spend authorization. There were no questions from floor.

Broty Stelly, Communications Specialist, Parking & Transportation Services, then presented "The Current State of LSU Parking & Transportation". The presentation included a history of the campus master plan approved in 2017 and the mobility plan add-on in 2019, and covered the resulting current and pending changes that are happening regarding parking on campus. There were multiple questions from the floor, including concerns over scooters on campus, bus hubs, horticulture changes, city transit, early closures on gamedays, transparency of expenditures, effect on the various stakeholders, and infrastructural issues like poor bike lanes.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:39 pm following a motion by Baldridge. The motion was passed unanimously.
